



### Beginner's Quilting Class

In Class you will make as many four patch quilt blocks as time allows. The materials will be provided and blocks retained to donate to a group that makes quilts for kids. You will be cutting and sewing the pieces together. This will be the beginning of learning to quilt. We will take the quilt blocks and arrange them to see the different ways to design the quilt. I will be demonstrating the way to finish the quilt. This will be a step-by-step class and sewing at your own pace.

#### The needed supply list is as follows:

**Rotary Cutter:** (in the class on Tools for Quilting you will know what you need).

**Rotary Blades:** That fits your Rotary Cutter (Tools Class as well)

**Klutz Glove:** (you may want to order the glove from the store or check online)

**Seam Ripper**

**Scissors:** (small ones for snipping the threads)

**Sewing Machine Supplies:** (you will need to be knowledge about your machine)

Extra sewing machine needles (quilting needles 75/11 or 90/14)

Bobbins (pre-wind 2 bobbins before class with light grey thread)

Thread (use Mettler light grey and for your bobbin as will or your choice)

Pins (glass heads are the better choice)

**Rulers** 6.5 x 12.5 (covered in the Tools class)

**Self-Healing Mat:** (covered in the Tools class)
