

Feet Fetish 2023 Wonky Texture Quilt  
January Block 1-3 Supply List

## Supplies for Blocks 1,2,3

- \_Tear Away Light Stabilizer or Stitch in the Ditch stabilizer
- \_7/9-Hole Cord Foot w/Threader or 11 Hole Cord Foot for IDF System
- \_Braiding Foot
- \_Narrow Braid/Cord Foot
- \_Assorted colors of size 5 perle cotton or hand embroidery thread strands or thick thread to go thru holes in 7/9-hole cord foot.
- \_Baby rick rack
- \_1/8" wide ribbon, at least 2 colors
- \_Robison-Anton rayon embroidery thread
- \_Bobbin Thread

## Cut before coming to class:

Begin by cutting **three squares 9" x 9"** (The blocks will be cut down to a finished 7 1/4" after embellishment is finished) from **EACH** of the **ten to twelve tone on tone** fabrics (NOT the black and white ones). This gives you approximately 24 squares to choose from, for the texture center squares in the blocks. You will be using 24 of them but you could cut extras, so you have a choice as you choose the colors. The extras could be cut into strips and can be used in the applique block.

Cut Three 9" X 9" squares of tear away stabilizer to use a backing for your 3 fabric squares.

## Prep:

Spray starch your fabric squares before coming to class. It gives them nice body.

Always bring your machine in good working order with all accessories, cords, and foot pedal. Bring different needles, and a small cutting mat and rotary cutter if you choose. You can also bring your own small iron and pad if you like. Basic sewing supplies are always needed, call Rebecca @ 832-745-3469 if you have any questions.
