

Participants in this camp should be able to operate their machine independently. Absolute beginners should enroll in either Beginner Charity Bear Camp or Beginner Sleep Accessories Camp first, which includes basic machine operation.

Bring from home:

Sewing Machine in good working order. Don't forget all the cords, accessories, bobbin and the book if you have it.

Machine rental is available from McDougals for \$15/day, call to reserve

Sewing kit to include Scissors, seam ripper, long ball head pins, pin cushion or magnetic pin holder, erasable fabric marker, tailor's chalk or chalk pencil, measuring tape, and 6" seam gauge.

A complete sewing kit is available from McDougals on the day of camp for \$49

Project supplies: For Crocodile-

- $\frac{1}{3}$ yard "Minky" fabric or polar fleece for the top.
- $\frac{1}{3}$ yard polar fleece for the bottom.
- 1 sheet felt for back scales.
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard jumbo rick rack for teeth (or 1 sheet white felt.)
- Felt scraps (or buttons) for eyes.
- 1 16 oz bag polyfill stuffing.
- Thread
- Hand sewing needle.

Optional: fabric clips For Penguin:

- $\frac{1}{3}$ yard polar fleece for the body (black)
- $\frac{1}{4}$ yard polar fleece for the belly (white)
- Felt scrap for eyes, beak, and head (black, white, yellow)
- 1-2 oz bag of polyfill stuffing
- Hand sewing needle.
- Thread
