

Participants in this camp should be able to operate their machine independently. Absolute beginners should enroll in either Beginner Charity Bear Camp or Beginner Sleep Accessories Camp first, which includes basic machine operation.

Bring from home:

Sewing Machine in good working order. Don't forget all the cords, accessories, bobbin and the book if you have it.

Machine rental is available from McDougals for \$15/day, call to reserve

Sewing kit to include Scissors, seam ripper, long ball head pins, pin cushion or magnetic pin holder, erasable fabric marker, tailor's chalk or chalk pencil, measuring tape, and 6" seam gauge.

A complete sewing kit is available from McDougals on the day of camp for \$49

Project supplies:

- $\frac{5}{8}$ yard of 45" wide cotton fabric for basket outside
- $\frac{5}{8}$ yard of 45" wide coordinating fabric for basket inside
- $\frac{1}{3}$ yard of 45" wide coordinating fabric for basket binding
- 1 yard of 45" or wider fusible fleece (found with interfacings)
- Thread to match basket binding fabric
- 9" or longer zipper (to coordinate with binding fabric for zippered pouch)
- Optional: fabric clips*

*fabric clips can be very helpful for this project. They can be found on Amazon for a reasonable price, or in fabric stores.
